# ORACLES

The Sabacc Oracle. Created by the Ryn, sacred to the Guardians of the Whills, and revered by the Church of the Force

The alien species known as the Ryn were the inventors of the Sabacca, a set of oracular tiles scribed on leather hide and used to divine the Will of the Force for an individual. Over time, crystal light chips were embedded in the leather slips, the precursor of modern holo-chip cards. It was even said that some Ryn tiles were stitched with slivers of Kyber crystal, which could reflect back the subconscious mind of a Force-sensitive querant, and manifest signs of their destiny through the tile images. They became a fundamental component of spiritual practise for many sets that reversed and observed the ways of the Force.

The use of Sabacca has been known amongst the Jedi, but the formalist traditions of the Jedi Order have long classified the use of Sabacca oracles as superstitious in nature. Latterly the study of the Oracle was prohibited, in line with the Order's distrust of prophecy. However, with the dissolution of the order, it is rumoured that some Jedi survivors have returned to the old ways of Sabacca.

Through the centuries, sabacc cards spread through the space ways and along the hyper-lanes, and became the basis for many card-based games and past-times whose purpose was entertainment and gambling rather than spiritual insight. By the time of the High Republic, Sabacc had become one of the most popular forms of entertainment for spacers and players from the Core to the Outer Rim, beating out other popular games like Pazaak. With the rise of secular variants of Sabacc, design and revision of Sabacc cards evolved away from the traditional form of the Oracle. The Corellian Spike deck, one of the most popular contemporary forms, is said to have been born out of the famous Corellian disdain for mysticism and spirituality. Nevertheless, the traditional form of the Oracle is preserved in many pre-eminent Sabacc styles such as Classical, Centran Tournament, Bordegun and Empress Teta Preferred.

# THE PRACTISE OF READING SABACC ORACLES

At the core of the Jedi and Whilst teaching is the interconnection between all living and manifest things within the energy field known as the Force. Through these precepts we understand that 'The Force is in me, and I am One with the Force'. The Sabacc Oracle is simply another kind of space in which we may reflect upon our place within and relationship to the Force. In this way it is akin to any meditation space, sanctuary or temple. Some look down on sabacca because of the material nature of its tools - the cards and their decorative symbols or pictographs - while seemingly blind to the use of elaborate iconography in their own temples, or their reverence for the clarifying power of kyber and adegan crysals.

The goal of Sabacc is to form as strong a conduit as possible between the Force, our own Self, and the Oracle, which reflects the state of our mind back to us. In the act of forming a Sabacc Array, we trust that our smallest actions are influenced by the subtle prompting of the Force, guiding us to the proper cards and sequence. Once an Array has been formed, the real work of the Oracle begins as the Seeker examines and meditates upon the meanings of the Cards. Here, a process of projection takes place between the Oracle and the mind of the Querant. The images of the Sabacc are based upon images and archetypes drawn from the collective visual language of all sentient beings in the Universe. As we contemplate these patterns drawn from the collective Inner Vision, our mind projects its own spiritual responses and patterns onto the symbols of the cards. In moments of optimal clarity, this meeting of mind and Force can give us powerful glimpses into the hidden nature of the present, and even gesture toward the emercent future.

A cautionary note. It is important to remember that no reading of the Sabacca represents your final destiny. When consulting the oracle, think of it as an aid to your intuitions, and a guide to the prevailing currents in the Force. Those ripples may be favourable or unifavourable to your purpose, but they cannot ultimately decide your future. 
### CENTRAN SABACC



Centran Sabacc uses a 78 card deck, differentiated from the

Centain Jabet Custs and a Value Section of 22 Major Aspect cards, although there are other differences. The 78-card game is known as "Centran" by association with the popular Oseon Sabact Couraments held in the Centrality Sector. The design of Centran decks actually follows after the oldest form of Sabacc—the Oracle Deck, originally invented by the ancient Ryn as an aid to prophecy and fortune-telling. The Ryn survive to this day, and still practise 'sabacca reading'. While modern Centran and Oracle decks use holo-chips which 'shift' randomly to become different cards during play, ancient Oracle cards are said to have been stitched with slivers of Kyber crystal, with images that changed in response to vibrations in the Force.

#### Oracle Dice

When an Oracle deck is not displayed on dynamic holo-chips but printed on filmsi-stock, a fortune teller will sometimes use Oracle Dice, marked with the signs of Ashla, Bogan and Bendu to determine whether a card should be read according to its base alignment. On rolling a pair of an alternate symbol, the teller will turn a card upside down to indicate an opposite alignment, or rolling a pair of an alternate symbol, the understand alignment, or side ways to indicate an uncertain alignment.


#### Oracle Card Alignment

Every card in the Sabacc oracle has positive or negative meanings, as well as a dominant alignment, showing whether a positive or negative meaning should normally be read. This alignment is indicated by three symbols. Ashla (Positive). Bogan (Negative), and Bendu, (Uncertain). However, with a holo-chip card, this alignment may sometimes shift, so that the card stays the same but the symbol changes.

In a simple binary oracle (a "Yes or No" question), Ashla can be read as Yes and Bogan as a No. Bendu (Uncertain) can be taken as a sign to wait ("Not Yet") or to draw further cards, perhaps reframing or contextualising your query.

## SETTING FOR A READING

When preparing to read a Sabacc Oracle, you are entering into the role of Seeker. This is the act of creating and holding a spiritual space where your Inner Being and the Living Force can be brought into greater alignment.

#### Reading Area

Many Oracle readers will carry a plate, cloth, mat or other surface on which to perform the reading.

#### Oracle Deck +

Practitioners of the Oracle have a closer Deck, which come in many variants. As well as tiles, card stoke, plasticards and holo-chip types, there are also many different design styles and lineages with their roots in Ryn, Jedi and planetary oracular traditions.

#### 4 Force Resonator

An optional aid to the practice of Sabacca is the use of a Resonator, objects (like kyber crystals) that are known to channed the Force. The Resonator brings the current of the Force into greater alignment with the Seeker. The clarity of the mind is enhanced and the act of interpreting the Cards is aided. Some will even use Force sensitive animals as resonators.

#### Oracle Dice

The Seeker uses the Oracle dice to determine the alignment of cards in the reading as required.

Oracle dice can also been used as an independent tool for asking questions. The Seeker poses a

question and rolls the paired dice to reveal a positive, negative or uncertain answer.

#### Card Array H

Different types of Oracle readings can be performed by employing a wide variety of Sabac Arrays. The most common styles of annay are the Binary Oracle, the Triadic Karay and the Centran Star. However, many other array types exist and can use up to 12 or 13 cards at a time. Advanced arrays types include Master Arrays, used for onnanced analysis of the Seeker's Circumstances, and Mistress Arrays, which probe the subtletes of interpersonal relationships.

#### Meditation Circle

While many practitioners employ only the judimentary tools of the Oracle, establishing a meditative space for the Seeker will all, the reading meditative space for the Seeker will all, the reading may seek to unburden your mind and seek the promptings of the CRE Beginners often draw out the circle as a part of their meditative practise, but experienced Seekers will form the circle as a mental projection.

## READING THE ORACLE

When preparing to read a Sabacc Oracle, you are entering into the role of Seeker. Such an act can only be accomplished by a quiet mind and a humble spirit. A 5th or darksider, dealing only in absolutes, have little patience for the complexities of the oracle and the subtleties of it's interpretation. It may help for you to follow these steps to prepare yourself:

- 1 Clear your mind. Let go of your conscious thought, and trust your feelings.
- 2 Close your eyes. In your mind, draw a meditation circle.
- 3 Reach out with your feelings. Let the force flow between you and the cards the cards and the boundary of your circle.
- 4- In your mind, form the question to which you hope to receive an answer. Strive to form this question from a state of calm and neutrality, and avoid emotive and unbalanced language which may twist the direction of the Oracle and it's interpretation.
- 5- With the question clear in your mind, shuffle the oracle cards. Your success rests on the clarity of your belief that this act is guided by the hand of the Force. For some querants, it helps to repeat a prayer or meditative mantra. One such invocation used by the Guardians is 'The Force is with me; I am one with the Force'; another is 'Do or do not; there is no try.' Some may recite the precepts of the Jedi code.
- 5 You may wish to open your eyes, or keep them closed. Now, draw the cards and place them within your chosen array.
- 6 Begin your reading. Be guided by your learning of the Sabacca oracle and your knowledge of the force.
- 7 If your reading is unclear or uncertain, place the oracle aside. Put aside time for meditation, and return to the oracle when your mind is clear and you have a greater sense of balance.

#### BINARY ORACLE

Binary Oracles are the most elementary form of Sabacc Oracle: the yes/no question. They involve a focused question and one card which can be interpreted as meaning yes," or of 'clouded'. A Binary reading may be employed to make a decision. You might consult the oracle to decide if you should do something, like undertake a journey, or make a no overture toward someone. A binary oracle can be used to determine whether a particular action is likely to fail or succeed in the immediate future. A typical query might be "Will I succeed on this mission?" or "Will the negotiations be short?"

A binary query must be framed as a singular and closed yes or no question; it should not be an open question, or multiple questions disguised as one. One must strive to keep their balance in framing their query, without using overfly negative or positive language that will bias the question.



YES, NO or CLOUDED

CLOUDED can be taken as a sign to wait ('Not Yet') or to draw a qualifier card, or perhaps to reframe or contextualise your query.



Optional card to bring clarity, especially to an CLOUDED result. A qualifier can be used to find context, the causes or reasons for the result, to seek a path toward changing the answer, or to further qualify the outcome, for example by revealing obstacles or what to do instead.

# A CHOSEN CARD

An archetype which you feels represents you, that sets the tone of your current difemma. For instance, for a question about love you might choose The Bonded, The Wounded, or The Fates, while a question about commerce or enterprise might call for the Prime of Coins, the Acquisitors, the Represents or the full visitors.

## TRIADIC ARRAYS

Io make a reading of an Oracle, the Seeker will draw a sequence of cards, known as an Array, There are many different types of Sabacc Array which can be employed in a reading. The Triadic Array is the classic form of the Sabacca Oracle, providing enough cards for a deep and nuanced reading, without over-whelming the reader and complicitation the interpretation.

#### SIMPLE TEMPORAL ARRAY



The Temporal Triad provides a reading of unfolding events with a set of three cards that give insight into the Past, the Present and the Future. The first card reveals the dominant cause of the present situation, and should guide your interpretation of the conflict and its resolution. The second clarifies the influence you have over the course of events, the role you play or the nature of your conflict with the forces which are in play. The third card shows the likely outcome of these events and the consequences for you. By careful reading of the preceding cards. You may intuit the meaning of the card in this isosition.

## LANDO'S SABACC READING

In the Legends novel Lando Calrissian and the Mindharp of Sharu, Lando performs an Oracle reading during a journey to heart of an ancient Sharu Monolith. He interprets the cards for his sceptical co-pilot, the pentapod droid known as Vuffi-Ra.

The Five of Sahers are The Accasoles for whom success comes at another's Lando's mercenary interest in other people's money at the Saharr table

The Six of Sabers are The Qutlanders, travellers on a inurney that is coming to an end. The denouement of Lando's adventure lies at the heart of the Monolith



The Bogan reappears On High-the Sahars shift allows the card to appear again. It represents Lando's great fear that Rokur Gepta is waiting for them at the end of their

The Wheel means Chance - uncertainty in the face of many possible outcomes, opportunities for success or

The Starship means Hazard - a warning of being detailed in flight, of danger or destruction in your

immediate path.

The Universe represents The Unifying Force. overwhelming power that controls your fate. It can also point toward the fulfilment of promises, dreams or potential. Lando seems concerned the overwhelming power may be Rokur Gupta but also recognises the positives inherent in the card and takes consolation from that .











DIF END

The Commander of Staves is The Envoy. a messenger on a fool's errand. Lando identifies with this card and believes it represents him in Oracle readings.

The Legate of Staves is The Advacate, who helps others and serves the preater good. Lando is amused by the idea he might secretly be a 'doopoder at heart'



THE SEEKFR

During the reading, the card drawn Against undergoes a Sabacc shift, showing two cards which Lando believes represent his enemies. The Bogan (also The Evil One) is Evil - a force of malignant intent. For Lando this means the Tund Someone Rokur Genta

The Legate of Coins is The Agent, a pragmatist who serves primarily their own interests. Duttes Mer, governor of Rafa IV, has blackmailed Lando

The Flag Cards depict the virtues and vices of individuals powerful in the aspect of the Living Force. Together, they depict our journey of emotional growth, connection, and understanding. They help us to understand our own feelings and the dynamics of our most important relationships.





The Flag cards show the virtues and vices of personalities who have mastered their creative energy and the ability to manifest their desires with confidence. Together, they remind us to trust our instincts, embrace our unique gifts, and unleash the full potential of our minds.

The Suit of Sabers (AKA Blades) embodies the Will of the Force and represents the realm of intellect, challenges, and the journey of the spirit. The Proto-Wesk is the symbol of the Willing Force, the guiding influence of the Force in the mind and the spirit. The Saber or Blade symbolises the power wielded by the spirit to effect change in the flow of the Force. When this suit emerges in an Oracle reading, it calls upon us to harmess the clarity of the mind, overcome obstacles with determination, and align our actions with the higher purpose guided by the Force.

The Ace represents the calling of the Force which rises within us as strong conviction. The Ranked Cards deal with matters of the mind, communication, challenges, and conflicts. The Flag cards represent the virtues and Vices of those with strong will, who display mastery of self and of the Force. They can offer guidance on the course of action to take when faced with difficult situations or decisions and remind us to stay true to our convictions, navigate through conflicts, and embody the strength of our spirits.

The Suit of Coins (AKA Medals, Talismans) represents the physical realm, practical matters, and themes of scarcity and abundance. The Proto-Esk symbol defines our interaction with the material aspect of life—the Binding Force—as Experience, our encounter with the forces that ground our material reality and define its bounds and limits. When this suit unfolds in an Oracle reading, it reveals the tangible aspects of life, our relationship with resources, and the material foundations we build. It encourages us to honour our bodies, make practical choices, and manifest our goals in the physical world.

The Ace represents the embodied power of the Force in our physical being and power, and the positive energy that resides there. The Ranked Cards represent the practical, material, and tangible aspects of life, such as wealth, resources, work, and stability. The Flag Cards represent the virtues and vices of individuals who have mastered the practical aspects of life and are powerful within the realm of the Binding Force. Together the Suit shows our journey through life and the practical manifestations of our efforts, providing insights into physical well-being, financial situations, and our relationship with our environment.





While the Minor Aspects focus on the everyday aspects of life and the development of the ego, the Major Aspect cards depict universal themes, life lessons, and transformative experiences. By focusing on the integrated power of the Unifying Force, the Major Aspects transcend individual identities and speaks to our collective experience, guiding us on a deeper level and connecting us to the larger tapestry of existence. By drawing our thoughs toward their archetypical energies they offer wisdom, transformation, and a deeper understanding of the interconnectedness that binds us together.

It consists of 22 archetypal cards which symbolise a journey of awakening and transformation, from the archetype of The Idiot' as our first state of Primitive Perception to The Universe' as a state of wholeness and unity with the Force. Between these two states we move from The Child to The World Between Worlds, experiencing the lessons, challenges, and revelations of each milestone, guided by the Force, facilitating personal growth, spiritual evolution, and a deeper understanding of the universal truths that connect us.
